

Pastor Gale's path to our door has not been exactly straight or predictable. With a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from University of Rhode Island and a master's degree in business from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, she began her working life in the late 1980's in the field of engineering as a designer, manager, and eventually consultant at Hamilton Sundstrand, a division of UTC. Meanwhile, she and her husband Terry were raising two daughters and serving on a variety of committees as active members of South Congregational Church in Granby. While working with UTC, she was able to begin the seminary education that would take her on a very different career path. In 2008, after twenty-seven years in the field of engineering, Pastor Gale was called to leave the engineering world and step off into a new phase in her life. She set to work to complete her seminary training at

Andover Newton Theological School, earning several honors during her time there along the way. 
